The appeal shall be held in abeyance pending determination of State v. Young (COA13-646), State v. Seam (COA13-1066), or State v. Perry (COA13-1117).

The following Order was entered:

On 1 May 2013, Defendant filed a motion for appropriate relief in Superior Court seeking resentencing based upon the United States Supreme Court's decision in Miller v. Alabama, 567 U.S.\_\_\_,183 L.Ed2d (2012). By order filed 29 July 2013, Judge Orlando F. Hudson, Jr., allowed Defendant's motion for appropriate relief and ordered resentencing. In December 2013, this Court allowed the State of North Carolina's petition for writ of certiorari to review the order. The State's appeal was held in abeyance pending determination of State v. Young (80A14), State v. Seam (82A14), and State v. Perry (81A14) by the North Carolina Supreme Court. On 21 December 2016, the North Carolina Supreme Court filed decisions in each case holding that Miller v. Alabama, is retroactive and remanding for resentencing. See State v. Young, N.C.\_\_\_, 794 S.E.2d 274 (2016); State v. Seam, N.C.\_\_\_, 794 S.E.2d 439 (2016); and State v. Perry\_\_\_\_N.C.\_\_\_, 794 S.E.2d 280 (2016).

It is therefore ordered that the State's appeal is dismissed and this case is remanded to the Superior Court, Durham County, for proceedings not inconsistent with our Supreme Court's holdings in State v. Young, State v. Seam, and State v. Perry.
