The following Order was entered:

On 5 May 2014, this Court allowed defendant's petition for writ of certiorari to review Judge James Floyd Ammons, Jr. s 5 September 2013 order denying defendant's motion for appropriate relief seeking resentencing based upon the United States Supreme Court's decision in Miller v. Alabama, 567 U.S.__, 183 L.Ed.2d (2012). Defendant's appeal was held in abeyance pending determination of State v. Young (80A14), State v. Seam (82A14), and State v. Perry (81A14) by the North Carolina Supreme Court. On 21 December 2016, the North Carolina Supreme Court filed decisions in each case holding that Miller v. Alabama, 567 U.S.__, 183 L.Ed.2d 407 (2012), is retroactive and remanding for resentencing. See State v. Young, ___ N.C.__, 794 S.E.2d 274 (2016); State v. Seam, ___ N.C.__, 794 S.E.2d 439 (2016); and State v. Perry ___ N.C.__, 794 S.E.2d 280 (2016).

It is therefore ordered that the trial court's order denying defendant's motion for appropriate relief is reversed and this case is remanded to the Superior Court, Cumberland County, for proceedings not inconsistent with our Supreme Court's holdings in State v. Young, State v. Seam, and State v. Perry.
