The petition filed in this cause by defendant Paris J. Todd on 12 March 2015 and designated 'Petition for Writ of Certiorari Under App. R.21 (e)' is allowed as follows: A writ of certiorari is hereby issued to review the order entered 16 January 2015 by Judge Donald W. Stephens in Wake County Superior Court denying defendant's motion for appropriate relief. The Superior Court, Wake County, shall determine whether petitioner is entitled: (1) to the appointment of counsel; (2) to proceed as an indigent; (3) to a copy of the transcript at the expense of the State; and (4) to be released on bond pending appeal. The appeal shall be deemed taken as of the date of the trial court's determination of whether defendant is entitled to appointment of counsel. The record on appeal shall thereafter be settled in accordance with N.C.R. App. P. 11, and the settled record on appeal shall be filed in this Court in accordance with N.C.R. App. P. 12(a).

A copy of this order shall be mailed to the senior resident superior court judge of judicial district 10, the district attorney, and Appellate Defender Staples S. Hughes.
