The petitions filed in this cause by the State on 13 October 2015 and designated 'State's Petition for Writ of Certiorari' and 'Petition for Writ of Supersedeas' are decided as follows: A writ of certiorari is hereby issued to review the order entered 21 September 2015 by Judge W. Douglas Parsons in Johnston County Superior Court allowing defendant's motion for appropriate relief and ordering resentencing. The State's petition for writ of supersedeas is allowed and the 21 September 2015 order is hereby stayed pending disposition of the State's appeal. The appeal shall be held in abeyance pending the North Carolina Supreme Court's determination of State v. Young (80A14-1), State v. Seam (82A14-1), or State v. Perry (81A14-1).

The petition and motion filed in this cause by petitioner on 13 October 2015 and designated 'Petition for Writ of Supersedeas and Application for Temporary Stay' are decided as follows: The motion for temporary stay is allowed. The order entered 21 September 2015 by Judge W. Douglas Parsons in Johnston County Superior Court allowing defendant's motion for appropriate relief and ordering resentencing is hereby stayed pending this Court's ruling on the State's petition for writ of supersedeas. This Court will rule on the State's petition for writ of supersedeas upon the filing of a response to the petition or the expiration of the time for a response if no response is filed.

The following order was entered:

The petition filed in this cause by defendant Delmonte Percell Jefferson Jr. on 29 October 2015 and designated 'Cross-Petition for Writ of Certiorari' is allowed. It appearing that this Court previously allowed the State's petition for writ of certiorari to review the order entered 21 September 2015 by Judge W. Douglas Parsons in Johnston County Superior Court allowing defendant's motion for appropriate relief and ordering resentencing, the writ of certiorari is hereby issued to allow additional review of the superior court's determination that defendant's guilty plea to first degree murder was supported by the theory of premeditation and deliberation. Defendant's appeal from the 21 September 2015 order shall be brought as part of the appeal being brought by the State, which is being held in abeyance pending the North Carolina Supreme Court's determination of State v. Young (80A14-1), State v. Seam (82Á14-1), or State v. Perry (81A14-1).

The following Order was entered:

By order filed 21 September 2015, Judge W. Douglas Parsons allowed Defendant's motion for appropriate relief and ordered resentencing based upon the United States Supreme Court's decision in Miller v. Alabama, 567 U.S.\_\_,183 L. Ed.2d (2012). In October 2015, this Court stayed Judge Parsons' order and allowed the State of North Carolina's petition for writ of certiorari to review the order. On 12 November 2015, this Court allowed Defendant's cross-petition for writ of certiorari 'to allow additional review of the superior court's decimination that defendant's guilty plea to first degree murder was supported by the theory of premeditation and deliberation.' The State's appeal and Defendant's appeal were held in abeyance pending determination of State v. Young (80A14), State v. Seam (82A14), and State v. Perry (81A14) by the North Carolina Supreme Court. On 21 December 2016, the North Carolina Supreme Court filed decisions in each case holding that Miller v. Alabama, is retroactive and remanding for resentencing. See State v. Young, \_\_\_\_\_N.C.\_\_\_\_, 794 S.E.2d 274 (2016); State v. Seam, \_\_\_\_\_N.C.\_\_\_\_, 794 S.E.2d 439 (2016); and State v. Perry \_\_\_\_\_N.C.\_\_\_\_, 794 S.E.2d 280 (2016).

It is therefore ordered that the State's appeal is dismissed, the stay is dissolved, and this case is remanded to the Superior Court, Johnston County, for proceedings not inconsistent with our Supreme Court's holdings in State v. Young, State v. Seam, and State v. Perry.

As to Defendant's limited appeal from the 21 September 2015 order by Judge Parsons, it is further ordered: The Superior Court, Johnston County, shall determine whether petitioner is entitled: (1) to the appointment of counsel; (2) to proceed as an indigent; (3) to a copy of the transcript at the expense of the State; and (4) to be released on bond pending appeal. Review shall be limited to the superior court's

determination that defendant's guilty plea to first degree murder was supported by the theory of premeditation and deliberation. The appeal shall be deemed taken as of the date of the trial court's determination of whether defendant is entitled to appointment of counsel. The record on appeal shall thereafter be settled in accordance with N.C.R. App. P. 11, and the settled record on appeal shall be filed in this Court in accordance with N.C.R. App. P. 12(a).
