The petition filed in this cause by defendant Terry R. Laxton on 17 November 2015 and designated 'Petition for Writ of Certiorari' is allowed to review the judgments entered 17 September 2014 by Judge Mark E. Klass in Davie County Superior Court. The Superior Court, Davie County, shall determine whether petitioner is entitled: (1) to the appointment of counsel; (2) to proceed as an indigent; (3) to a copy of the transcript at the expense of the State; and (4) to be released on bond pending appeal. The appeal shall be deemed taken as of the date of the trial court's determination of whether defendant is entitled to appointment of counsel. The record on appeal shall thereafter be settled in accordance with N.C.R. App. P. 11, and the settled record on appeal shall be filed in this Court in accordance with N.C.R. App. P. 12(a).

A copy of this order shall be mailed to the Senior Resident Superior Court Judge of Judicial District 22B, the District Attorney, and Appellate Defender Glenn Gerding.
