SPECIAL ORDER

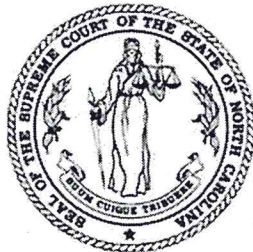
