# ORDER

(3) my solemn oath to serve on North Carolina's Court of last resort, rather

than recusing myself to avoid public scrutiny or criticism; and,

(4) my resulting judicial duty to all North Carolinians and my personal ability

to fairly and impartially discharge that duty.

For the reasons summarized above, specifically including the denial on the

merits of the identical Motion in this same case over a year ago, the present Motion

for Disqualification is Dismissed as Moot.
